FLAMED

This finish is achieved by applying fire with a blowtorch directly to the material. This makes it possible to make better use of the stone, as it eliminates any differences in tone that may appear in the natural stone, homogenizing the material's colors and making it opaque, making it suitable for external projects.

BUSH HAMMERED

This finish consists of chopping the material with pencils, resulting in a rough surface, but with a very unique finish that provides the same effect as flamed, but in a less aggressive way. It is widely used as a non-slip surface on sidewalks, pool edges and outside areas.

LEATHER

In this finish, the material is worked with diamond brushes, resulting in a different aesthetic effect, without the same flatness as material polished with abrasives. It gives a leather effect to the material, which can be used as coverings, countertops, decoration, thresholds and a multitude of other uses.

SAND BLASTED

This finish is obtained by applying compressed air and high-pressure sand or water to the sheet, producing a porous and matt aesthetic effect, suitable for places that need non-slip flooring and cladding.



POLISHED

Polished finishes can be resin or direct. Resin finishes receive a layer of epoxy resin to correct imperfections, enhance color and reduce porosity. Direct polishing transforms the raw material into a shiny, even surface, but with less pore closure and color enhancement. Both are suitable for internal applications.

HONED

This finish consists of regularizing the surface of the slab, giving it a smooth but matte finish. It can be used on worktops, islands, cladding and floors.

SATIN

This finish consists of regularizing the surface of the slab, similar to levigating. Its differential lies in a sequence of diamond brushes that give the surface of the material a slight roughness. It is widely used on coverings, floors, islands and worktops.

RIPPED

This finish can be applied to different types of surfaces. Using a specific tool, grooves are made with similar spacing, giving the slatted effect to the sheet. It is widely used to decorate walls, islands and worktops.

GRAFITTI

This finish can be applied to various types of surfaces. Using a diamond blade, grooves are made 4mm apart, giving the effect of graffiti on the slab. It is widely used to decorate walls, islands and worktops.

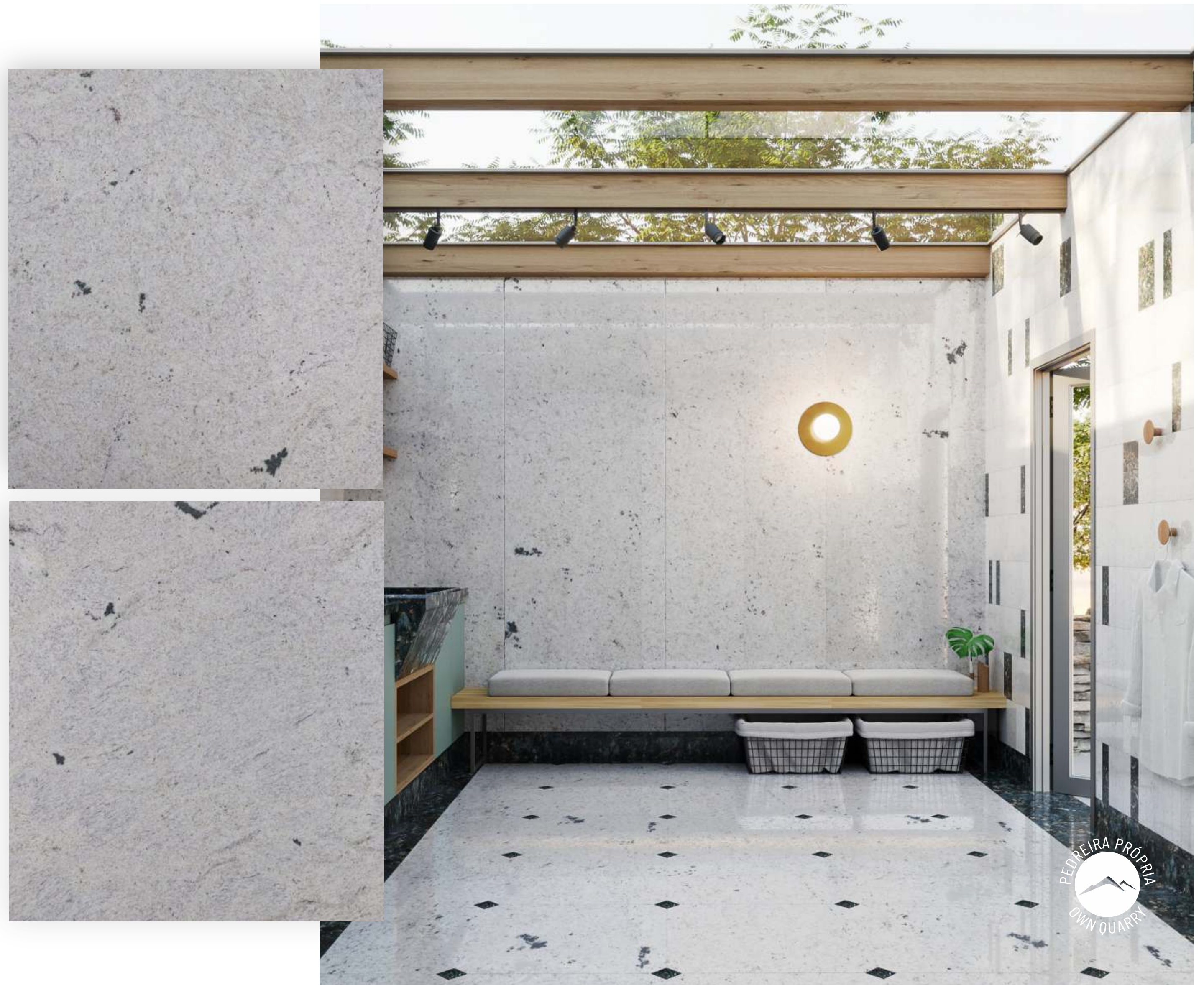
